## Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord: Liturgy of the Word

From the book of Daniel (Dn 7:9-10, 13-14)

As I watched: Thrones were set up and the Ancient One took his throne. His clothing was bright as snow, and the hair on his head as white as wool; his throne was flames of fire, with wheels of burning fire. A surging stream of fire flowed out from where he sat; Thousands upon thousands were ministering to him, and myriads upon myriads attended him. The court was convened and the books were opened.

As the visions during the night continued, I saw: One like a Son of man coming, on the clouds of heaven; When he reached the Ancient One and was presented before him, The one like a Son of man received dominion, glory, and kingship; all peoples, nations, and languages serve him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion that shall not be taken away, his kingship shall not be destroyed.

While he was still speaking, behold, a bright cloud cast a shadow over them, then from the cloud came a voice that said, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him." When the disciples heard this, they fell prostrate and were very much afraid. But Jesus came and touched them, saying, "Rise, and do not be afraid." And when the disciples raised their eyes, they saw no one else but Jesus alone. As they were coming down from the mountain, Jesus charged them, "Do not tell the vision to anyone until the Son of Man has been raised from the dead."

### Fr. Bill's Musings

I can think of no better way of learning about our faith than by teaching the faith. It challenges me to put into words the actions we are called to live. Also, the student's observations and questions push me to pray, reflect and study so I might help them to better know the Lord we love and serve.

Those who teach the faith for our community are called Catechists. As representatives for Christ and His church they should be men and women who are trying to walk the talk. Perfection is not possible, but the effort to please the Lord matters. Students learn from both our words and our actions. They learn more from what we do than from what we tell them to do. Knowing all the answers is not as important as being humble and willing enough to admit that each of us is still learning... and then to seek a clarification or answer from a good Catholic source.

(1) Catechists should be confirmed Catholics who are able to receive communion, regularly attend Sunday Mass and other sacraments as needed. (2) They try to follow the Catholic Church's teachings on morality and behavior. Religious Education is not a forum for personal beliefs not in conformity with Catholic Teachings. (3) They need to be willing to study, to work with others and recognize that parents are the primary catechists of their children. (4) Finally, we want a confirmed adult in each classroom. More than one adult per class is preferred as health or family commitments do arise. Willing teens are encouraged to assist catechists as it will help them grow in the faith. Thank you for considering this important ministry.
