Monthly Pledge Fulfillment Collection

Our 2nd collection today is a combined collection. Cash and Building Fund envelopes will go 100% to the parish. Checks to "Called to Renew" as well as Called To Renew envelopes will go to CTR Campaign. \$353,763.62 has been contributed as of July 15th. This is just short of 35% of our CTR goal. Our 50% \$176,881.81 take away 13K (Doors) and 140K (Pews) leaves \$23,735.10 to be used toward other CTR projects at this time. Thank you for your help.

The church pew project will begin in earnest on Monday, September 23rd. One quarter of the pews will be taken that day. They will have all existing finish removed down to bare wood. This will be done with both machine and hand sanding. Cracks will be repaired with putty. All exposed wood will then receive a new stain (not "original sin") with a new wood finish. Artesian oil stain, a coat of sanding sealer and a clear top coat will be used to finish the benches. The kneelers will be repaired so they gently drop down. The kneeler pads will be replaced. When this has been completed (approximately three weeks estimated) the benches will be returned to the church and re-installed. The process will repeat until the 84 benches have been refreshed and re-installed, God willing, before the Feast of the Immaculate Conception. This will be our second completed Called To Renew project made possible through your generosity. The cost for this project is approximately \$140,000.00. The first completed project was the front doors being replaced and their closers repaired \$13,146.71.

Also, regarding two other Called To Renew projects, we are getting bids for our outdoor church and parking lot lighting, as well as bids for upgrading some of our fencing. Your continued generosity will help us respond to these needs more quickly. Thank you.

The summer's projects: cleaning church roof, drains, exterior windows and walls (10K), prep and painting exterior of church, retaining walls and planters (18K), painting hall interior (3.5K), church plumbing/bathrooms (1.2K), hall and church electrical repairs (6k), bus pad (9K), fence repair (2K), and landscaping (7k).

IT SEEMS PEOPLE'S CONCERNS REGARDING ZONING HAVE BEEN NOTICED. The city will be holding a meeting at St. Jerome on Thursday, August 29th at 6:30pm to present why the zoning change to the seven commercial/retail sites, church property, and all of the multi-family dwellings on Fairview and Springpark by the Ladera Center into zoning for mixed-use 6-8 story high rise buildings may actually benefit those who can afford to remain in the area. I hope that questions will be allowed and perhaps honestly answered. In checking out our hall, city reps did admit that the new apartment units would have higher rates than the units they will be replacing and would definitely require greater income to rent.

We are having a EUCHARISTIC PROCESSION at the end of the 8am mass on Saturdays of August. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament follows.

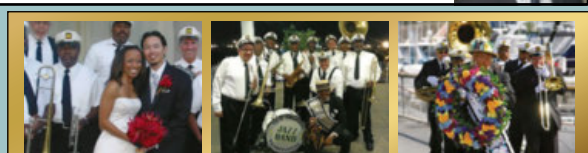
