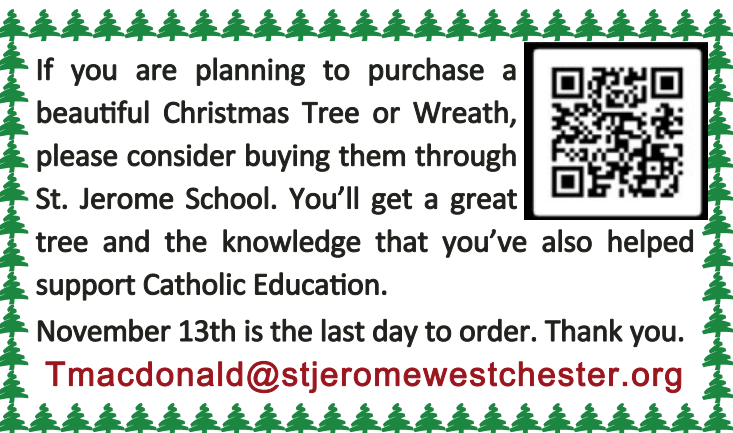


NICENE CREED
