A reception for the newly baptized adults after the Easter Vigil? A farewell for priests or staff? Coffee and pastries on Sunday morning? These are events a hospitality ministry MIGHT host. If they love cooking they could host a pancake breakfast on a Sunday.

It really depends on the people who are sharing their gifts, talent and time. They are the one's who will help shape what this Hospitality Ministry will be. It is the gift of welcoming and offering hospitality.

Perhaps you are gifted at planning, preparing and facilitating celebrations, parties and events. Or maybe your generous, hardworking and willing to help. FYI, THIS WILL IMPACT US.

Dear Neighbors' -

The County released their Environmental Impact for its Westside Area Plan. The public has about 15 days left to comment on their Plan to UPZONE seven commercial/retail sites, church property, and all of the multi-family dwellings on Fairview and Springpark by the Ladera Center into zoning for mixed-use 6-8 story high rise buildings. Please note the podcast says this zoning reclassification is to allow "Affordable" housing to be built in Ladera Heights. The zoning proposal does not have any requirement for a single low-income or ultra low-income (for the unhoused) units. Also, if they designate as few as 5% of the new units as "affordable" the State allows them to add additional stories on the buildings up to 9 stories.

"AFFORDABLE" is a relative term. Instead be specific and refer to low-, ultra-low, or moderate income units compared to luxury apartment rates.

The City and County Plans are

not about adding what we would define as "affordable" housing units. Both Plans propose to upzone parcels with rent-controlled rental units for moderate-income families. The residents in all of the existing moderately priced apartment, condos, duplexes or triplexes would be displaced. THE COST OF A DESIGNATED "AFFORDABLE" 1-BEDROOM UNIT IN THE HOWARD HUGHES REGIONAL CENTER JUST DOWN THE STREET, IS \$3500 PER MONTH AND THERE IS A MINIMUM INCOME REQUIREMENT OF \$120,000 PER YEAR. This will not solve the Affordable Housing Crisis!

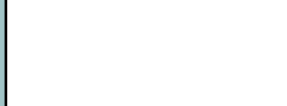
