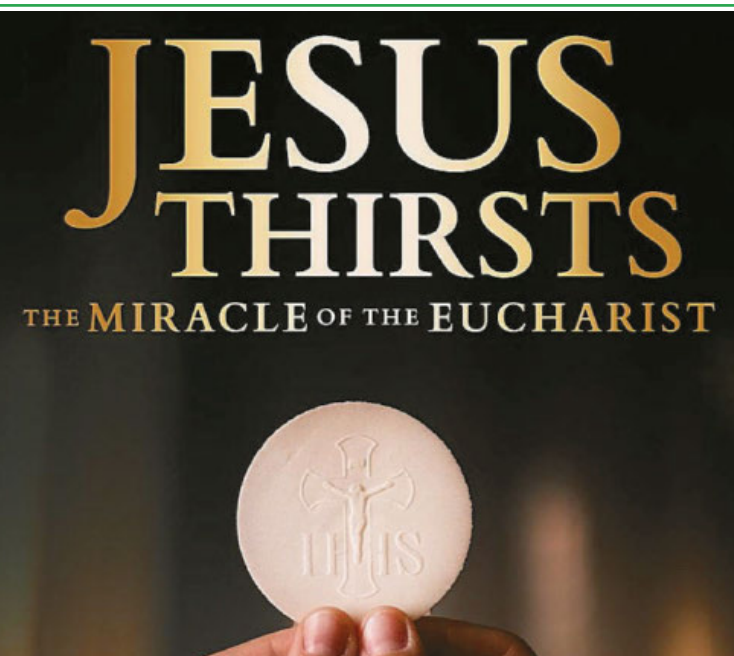


NICENE CREED

I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible.

I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through him all things were made. For us men and for our salvation he came down from heaven, and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. I made a promise to God some 48 years ago to use my musical talents and voice for praise and worship of Him. I sing of His glory in my personal prayer. The servants who because of their God given gift and their responsibility to build up the Body of Christ are humbly admitting "We are unprofitable servants; we have done what we were obliged to do." (Lk 17:10)

Yes, this is a Fr. Bill pet peeve. No, it is not a commandment. If you clap, so be it... but the reward I seek, only God can give.

Regarding the CHILDREN'S CHOIR, I demand 4 things of those I teach how to play instruments: say a prayer for me every day that I am your teacher, practice your instrument at least 20 minutes each day, sing in the Children's Choir and teach anyone I ask you to teach, how to play an instrument. By the way, if your child (3rd grade and has received their First Communion) would like to join our Children's Choir, come with your child and let's have a conversation in the next month about being in the choir.

This week you are encouraged to join with us following weekday mass to pray with us the OUR MOTHER OF PERPETUAL HELP NOVENA and the Rosary. **TODAY** we will pray the Novena in the parish hall and then have a Rosary Procession leading into the 10am Mass which will be in honor of Our Mother of Perpetual Help. The novena concludes on Thursday, June 27th, the Feast of Our Mother of Perpetual Help. All are welcome to join with us as both we and the world need prayer more than ever.

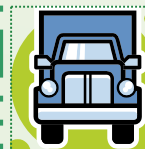

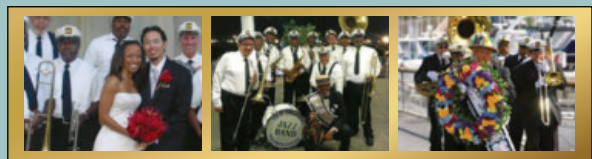
